EDITORIAL POLICY (2019)

The purpose of the Magazine

The purpose of the of BWPV Magazine is to promote and enhance the feeling of community within the parish by publishing information, articles, reports and notices (Editorial Content) and advertisements that inform, entertain or relate to church, the community and individual and organisations within it. This will include Editorial Content which reflects Christian beliefs.

Principles

1. The BWPV relies on written submissions from members of the community for the editorial content and anyone may submit material for publication. The Editor will seek to include submissions in a future edition of the BWPV provided always that it is in the absolute discretion of the editor considered to be relevant and of interest to the readership.
2. The Editor reserves the right to edit and not to publish. The Editor will not publish items that are of a contentious matter and may seek the guidance of the Rector and/or the PCC on editorial issues.
3. Submissions and one-off items received by BWPV shall be subject to the editing process and may be amended by the omission of parts or by correcting errors in spelling, grammar and punctuation whilst not altering the intent, purpose and meaning of the original.
4. Each issue of the BWPV will contain advertisements from individuals and organisations offering services and products to the local community but the publication of any advert does not carry the church's endorsement.
5. The Editor reserves the right to place within, or in close proximity to, any submission, any photograph or graphic illustration that is considered appropriate or which (in their sole discretion) enhances, comments on or draws attention.
6. The editor will accept items/advertisements promoting forthcoming one-off events but the size of those will be decided by the limitations of the space available.
7. The Editor has sole discretion as to the layout of the BWPV
8. Placing loose 'inserts' into the Magazine is not permitted.

The Policy approved by the Parochial Church Council on 13.1.20
